Foreword October 2025

The 21st September is a day that I will remember forever. It was the day that I was ordained deacon at West Malling church. in the Kent Downs and Malling benefice of seven churches. which includes Leybourne. It was, I hope, not just a special day for me, but one in which the local congregations were able to feel a part of. It is unusual for an ordination to be in the local church as they are normally held in the cathedral. Yet Lam. so pleased that it was. It seems fitting that the people to whom I have promised to serve, heard that commitment.

It signified the end of a long journey of listening to where I and the church discerned where God was leading me. Every clergy-person has a calling story. Some are more 'road to Emmaus' that is, a gradual realisation, some are more 'road to Damascus', a sudden, unexpected and dramatic encounter with God's intention. Mine was the latter which in no way makes it more significant than other people's experiences. The story is that I

was praying one day and I heard a voice in my head telling me to get ordained. This was quickly followed up by multiple people telling me the same and that St. Mellitus was the place to train (for me-there's a perfectly good training centre in West Malling). I don't think I would have listened to God if he hadn't made it so clear I had never considered ordination before but I concluded that I cannot take all the good things form God and call him Lord of my life and then ignore him when he asked something of me. Prayer is powerful and lifechanging! Be warned!!!

In a sense, the ordination service was like the harvest of theological education and much prayer. It is though, and is probably more importantly, the start of something new. It has always felt like a bit of an adventure, committing to journeying with God. You never quite know where he is taking you. Yet, he is an excellent guide. One in whom we can place our full trust in the knowledge that he loves each of us and has a plan for our lives- even if that takes us

to surprising places, or maybe nowhere at all, but one where he desires for us to walk each day with him, wherever we go and whatever we are doing. The Bible says, commit your ways to the Lord and he will make straight the paths for you. These are words of encouragement, yet even straight paths can have a few bumps, stones and tree roots to navigate! I pray that we all can help each other navigate some of these bumps. May I ask that you pray for me too? The beauty of Anglican ministry is that we are not just left to get on with it, but have the wisdom of those who have gone before us and the support of experienced clergy and lay ministers to guide us. I am grateful for them all. I am also reminded that ministry is not just for the ordained, its for all of us.

I am so looking forward to getting to know individuals, the community and the churches better. Thank you for your welcome so far, it means a lot.


