Many years ago, when I was in my school choir, we sang a song called Ring Out, Wild Bells in one of our Christmas concerts. It is a carol composed by Percy E. Fletcher, with words from the poem by Alfred, Lord Tennyson. That carol has always stayed with me. At the time, I didn't think too much about the words, I simply liked the tune, but as I grow older I find myself reflecting more deeply on their meaning.

"Ring out the old, ring in the new.

Ring, happy bells, across the snow:

The year is going, let him go; Ring out the false, ring in the true."

These words can bring us hope. As we approach the end of the year, we naturally look back on all that has happened. For some, the memories are joyful; for others, they carry sadness. Yet as we celebrate Christ's birth, we can look forward in faith, for we have been given a Saviour who

offers hope, healing, and reconciliation. He enables us to "ring out" bitterness and fear, and to "ring in" grace and peace, for his birth brings us both light and love.

At Leybourne, and throughout the Kent Downs and Malling Team, there will be many Carol, Christingle, Crib and Nativity services to help us prepare for that most special birth.

On Sunday 14 December, we will hold our All-Age Toy Service at 10.30am, where we will collect toys, ladies' gifts, and toiletries (please note: only new, unwrapped items can be accepted) for a local women's refuge.

On the evening of Tuesday 16 December, we will be singing carols and Christmas songs at The Old Rectory, and we warmly invite you to join us.

As we continue to work closely with the Leybourne Parish Council, The Old Rectory, and the wider community, we are deeply grateful for the




