

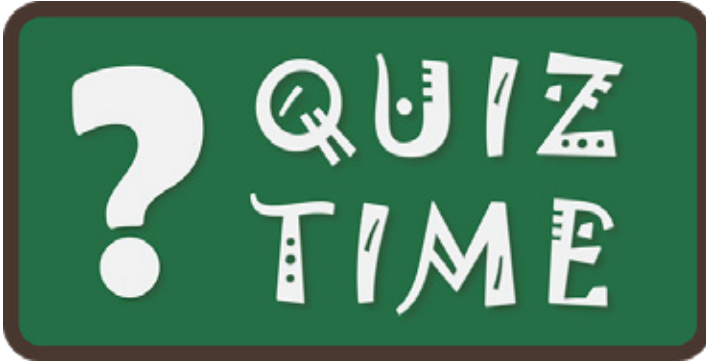

Lent sermon series 2026: **The God who Heals**

People often describe aspects of our society as 'broken.' It's a way of conveying a sense of sadness and frustration that things that used to seem simple now seem complicated, of naming a breakdown of connection.

Within our own lives we can also feel fragile, breakable. We may be supporting family members who are struggling, we may be feeling overwhelmed by the number of decisions we have to make every day, we may be simply wondering whether we are enough. Being surrounded by brokenness can lead us to ask the question-is there something more? Is there a way to find peace, meaning and wholeness amidst a world so full of anger and division?

One of the ways in which Christians understand Jesus is as a healer. Jesus comes to restore relationships, to bring us a deep and lasting peace which we cannot find anywhere else.

There's a story in the Bible about the good shepherd who leaves the rest of the flock in the sheepfold and goes out searching for the sheep that is lost. I had a picture book of that story when I was a child, and I always remember the final picture, where the shepherd

is putting ointment on the lost sheep's scratches and then carrying it very gently back home. It is a picture of Jesus the healer which I still find very powerful. Jesus the Saviour comes for the healing and restoration of all that is damaged, broken and divided- and that includes me.

This year in church we are using the six weeks of Lent to reflect on different aspects of healing. We will consider the physical, spiritual and relational aspects of healing and widen out to look at the healing of God's creation. Healing encompasses more than the restoration of an individual to physical health, and in our Sunday sermons we will consider the interlocking aspects of health, healing and wholeness.

Everyone is welcome to all and any of our 10.30 Sunday services throughout Lent. March 15 is Mothering Sunday, where our Melody Makers choir will be singing and we will celebrate all that brings us joy in human relationships.

Lent begins with two services at SS Peter & Paul on Ash Wednesday, February 18, one at 10am and the other at 7pm, to which all are welcome.

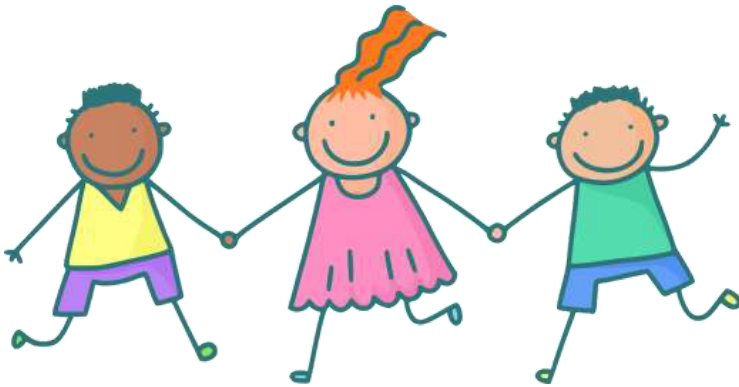

Winners of the Tonbridge and Malling Community Awards were presented with their certificates at a special ceremony at the Council Offices in Kings Hill last November.

Modest man that he is, Joe Shepherd's award of the major prize of the evening was kept quiet! He received the Outstanding Community Achievement Award for running four community choirs and a ukelele group in Larkfield and Leybourne, including sessions that use singing to help with stroke rehab. He also won an award for Individual Volunteer of the Year.

Joe told the audience at the time “I am truly honoured that somebody thinks I am worthy of such an award. I have found that I have a gift for enabling people to enjoy singing, and I absolutely love doing what I do. Whether the group is 15 or 50 members,

the principal aim is to have fun and make friends. I have a simple “yard stick” – ie if people don’t leave the session with a smile on their face, then I have failed! Fortunately, I don’t think that has ever happened!”.

Cllr Des Keers – Cabinet Member for Community Services – said “The dedication I’ve seen and heard about during these awards is an inspiring reminder of the impact that ordinary people can have when they turn ideas into action”.

If you have been thinking of coming to church why not come and join us – we look forward to welcoming you.

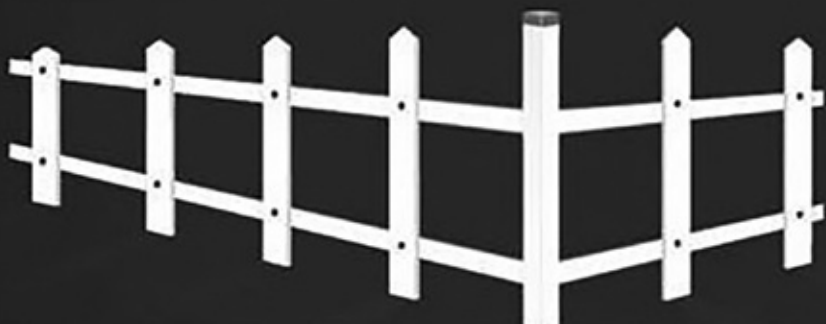
